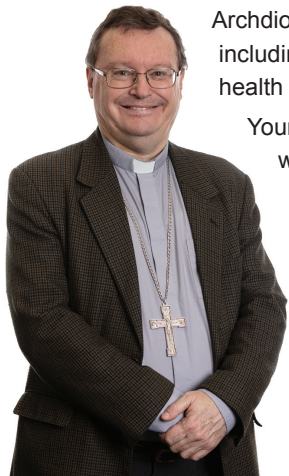
After a lifetime of sacrifice and service, no priest should face retirement with financial uncertainty.
