



On any given day in South Australia...

...**110 homeless young people, 10 families and 50 homeless women** are being cared for and accommodated. (*Centacare, St Joseph's Family Care Centre and Catherine House*)

...**20 people with intellectual disabilities** are being housed and cared for with support from Catholic Charities (*Ain Karim*) with a further 16 being housed and 20 supported through respite care. (*Centacare*)

...**pregnant or parenting young mums** are being housed with **10 continuing their school education** and another **10 using day care**. 140 young women assisted during the year. (*Louise Place*)

...**over 200 homeless people** are having a meal, using the showers, seeking medical treatment, using the laundry or just having somewhere safe to spend the day. (*Hutt Street Meal and DayCentre*)

...**5 people who have recently left prison** and another **85 people in need of help**, including inner city indigenous, refugees, homeless and needy people, will visit the drop-in centre to collect food and stay for a 'cuppa' hot pie or pastie. (*Aboriginal Catholic Community*)

...**57 couples** are receiving counselling or mediation for relationship problems. (*Centacare*)

...**137 children with special needs** and their families are receiving education or other support. (*Catholic Special Schools and Catholic Deaf Association*)
